Research Experience

Dr. Micillo Teresa started his training as internal student in immunology whiles she was at the School of "Biotechnological Science", University of Naples "Federico II" in 2014, working in the laboratory of Immunology at the Institute of Endocrinology and Experimental Oncology, (IEOS-CNR), Naples, Italy, under the supervision of Prof. Giuseppe Matarese. During this period of training, Dr. Micillo is focusing her attention on the mechanisms involved in the control of peripheral immune tolerance, mediated by regulatory CD4⁺CD25⁺FoxP3⁺ T cells (Tregs). The research field of Dr. Micillo has as its objective the study of the interactions between the immune system, metabolism and inflammation, both in physiological and in the course of autoimmune diseases such as Multiple Sclerosis and Type 1 diabetes (T1D).
